

Brief description of the subject of the contract	The subject of the contract is a research service consisting in the synthesis of peptides in a laboratory standard.

Purpose of the contract	The purpose of the contract is to select a subcontractor who, as part of the peptide synthesis service in laboratory standard, will provide up to 10 long-acting peptides for the implementation of a preclinical innovative therapeutic program for use in cardiovascular diseases.
Subject of the contract	research service based on the synthesis of peptides in a laboratory standard (non-GLP). The contract will cover the following tasks:
	Synthesis of linear peptide sequence of 15 to 20 amino acids with fatty acids or fatty diacids conjugated via










CPV code	short linkers, such as gamma-glutamic acid (g-Glu), 2-[2-(aminoethoxy)ethoxy]acetic acid (Aeea), or other short linkers. Peptides contain unnatural amino acids, including alpha-Methyl amino acids, D-amino acids, N-Methyl amino acids, beta-amino acids and amino acids with unnatural side chains. Peptides are synthesized at 20 mg scale and purified by RP-HPLC to greater than 90% purity and salt exchanged to acetate salts by ion-exchange chromatography. Peptides are characterized by LC-MS (liquid chromatography - mass spectroscopy) to confirm identity. The selected peptide, if it meets the assumed requirements, will be resynthesized on a scale of up to 500 mg. Detailed information on the subject and scope of the contract resulting from the project specifications should be read by e-mail or telephone after signing a confidentiality agreement. After the settlement of the procedure with the selected contractor, a CONDITIONAL AGREEMENT will be concluded, which will enter into force after the Contracting Authority signs the contract for financing the project to which this inquiry relates. Knowledge and experience

Bidders who meet the conditions for participation in the proceedings will be admitted to the proceedings, i.e.: they have knowledge and experience to perform a specific activity, if the law imposes the obligation to have such rights;

In particular, the tenderer shall document:

- i. experience in the synthesis of peptides with fatty acids or fatty conjugated diacids by means of short linkers such as gammaglutamic acid (g-Glu), 2-[2-(aminoethoxy)ethoxy]acetic acid (Aeea) or other short linkers, using unnatural amino acids and amino acids with unnatural side chains;
- ii. has access to commercial suppliers of intermediate compounds with a documented history of at least 1 year of acquisition of such compounds.


The Contracting party will consider that the Contractor capable of proper performance of the awarded contract is one that in the last three years before the deadline for submitting tenders, and if the period of conducting business activity is shorter – in this period, has completed at least 10 orders consisting in the synthesis of peptides on a laboratory scale.

METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:

- 1. The Contracting Authority shall assess the fulfilment of the conditions for participation in the proceedings on the basis of the Contractor's statement contained in the offer form (Attachment 1 to the Request for Tender). The assessment of compliance with the requirements will be made using the meet/does not meet method.
- 2. Documents requested by the Contracting Authority to confirm compliance with the conditions for participation in the procedure shall be submitted in the form of the original or a copy certified by the Tenderer.






	reserves the right to verify the Tenderer's statements (meets/does not meet) regarding the conditions for participation in the proceedings on the basis of relevant documents confirming the Tenderer's statement.

	METHOD OF ASSESSMENT:
	1. The Contracting Authority shall assess the fulfilment of the conditions for participation in the procedure on the basis of the Contractor's statement contained in the offer form (Attachment 1 to the Request for Proposal) and attached documents. The assessment of compliance will be carried out on a meet/does not meet method.

Additional terms and conditions	Each Tenderer may submit only one bid in electronic form, under pain of nullity of all bids of a given contractor in the event of multiple bids.









The contracting party does not allow for the possibility of submitting variant offers.

The contracting party does not allow for the possibility of submitting partial bids.

The contracting party does not allow for the possibility of submitting joint bids.

The contracting party reserves the right to cancel or cancel the proceedings in the event of failure to receive funding for the implementation of the project or the occurrence of circumstances that were not known at the stage of preparing the inquiry or the duration of the procedure.

In case of doubts or disclosure of errors or inaccuracies in the offer, the Contracting Party reserves the right to request the Tenderer or Tenderers to provide explanations. If a different price is specified in the offer and a different price in other documents – the Ordering Party shall accept the price specified in the offer form as the offer price. In the case of providing a different amount expressed numerically and another expressed in words – the Ordering Party shall accept the amount given in words as correct.

Conditions for amending the contract

The works carried out under the contract are an integral part of a research project involving industrial research and development and are therefore characterized by a high degree of uncertainty.


The contract may be amended in the cases referred to in section 3.2.4 of the Procurement Agreement Guidelines on eligibility of expenditure for the years 2021-2027.

The contracting authority allows for the possibility of introducing changes to the contract, including the deadline for the performance of the contract, in the event of a circumstance resulting from substantive or research reasons justifying the introduction of such changes.

In addition, the Contracting Party reserves the right to change the contract concluded with the entity selected as a result of the proceedings for the following reasons:










	1. Justified changes in the manner of performance of the subject of the contract,
	2. Objective reasons beyond the control of the Contracting Party or the tenderer,
	3. Force majeure circumstances,
	4. Changes in legal regulations in force on the day of signing the contract,
	5. Receiving a decision of the project financing entity containing changes in the scope of tasks, deadlines or setting additional provisions to which the Contracting Authority will be obliged.
	Any changes and additions to the contract concluded with the selected Contractor must be made in the form of written annexes to the contract signed by the parties, under pain of nullity.

Evaluation criteria and description of how scoring is awarded	With regard to Tenderers who have met the conditions for participation in the procedure, bids will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:
	Price ("C") – 100 points (weight of the criterion 100%)
	When calculating this criterion, the contracting party will take into account the net price in PLN for the performance of the subject of the contract. In the case of offers presented in EUR, USD or others, the net price









	converted into PLN will be taken into account using the NBP selling rate as of the date of publication of this inquiry on the Competitiveness Base portal. The tender with the lowest price will receive 100 points multiplied by the weight of the criterion and will be accepted as the basis for the examination of the remaining offers. Scoring for the prices of subsequent offers will be held according to the formula:
	How the number of points for bids under the criterion is calculated:
	Criterion "C" = Lowest price of SUM offers / Price of examined offers SUMA* 100 points * 100% (criterion weight)
	The contracting authority will choose the offer that obtains the highest number of points as the most advantageous.
Exclusion	Bidders who are personally or financially related to the Contracting Authority shall be excluded.
	Capital or personal ties shall be understood as mutual relations between the Contracting entity or persons authorized to incur obligations on behalf of the Contracting entity or persons performing activities related to the preparation and conduct of the contractor selection procedure and the contractor on behalf of the Contracting entity, consisting in particular in:
